The Ayuda y Amistad (AyA) club is CIC Community Service program. It gives students the opportunity to help the greater community by providing humanitarian assistance through community service. By offering "Ayuda y Amistad (meaning: 'help and friendship')", students interact with and learn about individuals and groups in the community that need assistance, and students develop skills for helping to make a positive difference in the lives of others. At times, Ayuda y Amistad organizes field trips to locations in the community such as orphanages, schools, hospitals, and community service agencies, in order to meet the objectives stated in the International Baccalaureate Middle Years and Diploma programmes. All students in grades 6-12 are encouraged to participate in this community service club.

Creativity, Activity, and Service (CAS) in the CIC Secondary School
