

CIC offers a wide range of after school enrichment programs to complement and enhance our curriculum. Our activities aim for children to learn while having fun in a safe environment. The purpose of CIC After-School Activities (ASA) is for recreational learning - not competition; and to keep the attention and the interest of the students for a period of time after the regular school day. Our program is built allow children to develop their self-esteem and problem solving skills as we offer activities that include arts, basketball, ceramics, chess, cooking, drama, football, music, robotics and more. Secondary students additionally participate in competitive activities and clubs after school.

After School Activities (ASA) are offered each term and are usually taught by CIC teachers – most are free of charge. Beforehand, there is a sign-up fair to which all parents are invited. After School Activities at CIC are usually offered Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday for elementary students, and also Fridays for secondary students. For the younger ones, class ends at 4PM, providing up to one hour of direct instruction, while the older students may have activities until 5PM.
